The Friends of St.Mary's Church

On behalf of the Friends may I offer a very warm welcome to our new Vicar, the Reverend David Newton, his wife Sally and little Toby. We hope that his ministry and their time here in Comberton will be very happy. David will be Licensed on 5 December.

The Friends were set up to raise money, so I am attentive to funding issues as well as my passion for history! Five hundred years ago this month Martin Luther pinned a notice to the door of the Kassel Church of Wittenberg, Germany. His principle complaint was the Churches' practice of selling "Indulgences". So began the Reformation.

In those days the Christian Church believed that Sinners went first to Purgatory when they died. Famous paintings of the period show some horrible practices going on there!

If you had the money, you could buy an Indulgence-a kind of "Get Out Of Jail Free" card. Luther discovered that the local priests were selling these Indulgences to enable the Archbishop to pay off his personal debts. Worse, when they sold an Indulgence they did not always explain all the conditions attached. Was this Medieval mis-selling perhaps?!!

Four hundred years later on the Western Front (1917) the Allies were close to defeat. Revolution took Russia out of the War and German troops headed for the Western Front. A new Allied Offensive in Flanders, the 3rd Battle of Ypres, was launched, but the Generals had learned nothing. Aided by American funding they had plentiful guns and shells for a big bombardment.

The bombardment opened on 22 July and lasted 10 days. It smashed the intricate network of drainage channels across the Flanders Plain. Combined with unusually heavy rains during the first 3 months, by October the battlefields had become a murderous swamp. Advance was not possible. Fighting and dying in the mud and mustard gas, the name of Passchendaele became synonymous with a new kind of Hell on earth.

I wonder if any of the men of Comberton were among the 400,000 British casualties at Passchendaele? Did any local families suffer grief and uncertainty that year-and perhaps find comfort in St.Mary's Church?

Our own fund raising programme continues with a Musical Workshop on Saturday afternoon 18 November in St Mary's Church. The Bedford Gallery Quire returns, this time to show us how we can all make or sing English Country music, as in the period of the late 1700s and early 1800s.

VILLAGE TRAFFIC

Since moving to Comberton just over 4 years ago, I have noticed, as have most of you, a significant increase in traffic through the village, and especially Long Road and Barton Road from the mini roundabout eastwards.

This of course is due to the increasing number of new properties being built, and with it the increasing number of commuters, and will only get worse with increasing numbers of properties planned.

The problem with all of this traffic, which can be up to 850 vehicles an hour at peak times and up to 150 per hour at other times, is not so much the volume but more the blatant disregard for speed limits, which adds to the danger to cyclists and pedestrians.

Since setting up the Community Speedwatch, the team has regularly clocked and reported vehicles travelling at 45–50mph and over in the 30mph limit on Long Road and 60mph plus on Barton Road which has a 40mph limit. We recently reported a car at 72mph in this area, and have noted many drivers overtaking at high speeds too. Overtaking at high speed of course brings added danger to cyclists even if they are on cycle paths.

Community Speedwatch is supported by Cambridgeshire Constabulary, Cambridgeshire County Council, and the local Parish Council with the aim of reducing speeding and improving driver behaviour in this area.

We currently only operate in the Long Road, and Barton Road areas, but are awaiting authority to operate in the Barton Road 30mph zone, West Street, and South Street/Royston Lane areas. When we get this authority we will need many more volunteers, so I am appealing for volunteers once again.

All that is required is approximately one hours training at Cambourne Police station. Once trained, a session can be anything from 1 to 2 hours and as little as once a month.

The Comberton Keep Fit group welcomes new members keen to improve or maintain their fitness. The group meets every Tuesday evening in the Sports Hall at Comberton Leisure through to May next year with only a short break at Christmas. Public urged to help combat hare coursing

MEMBERS of the public are being urged to be the eyes and ears of the county's rural communities by reporting ongoing hare coursing incidents.

Fields across Cambridgeshire have been harvested and ploughed making them the perfect ground for the illegal blood sport.

The hare coursing season traditionally began in September and causes damage to crops, harms animal welfare and threatens the rural community. It can result in intimidation and even violence.

Last year (April 2016-March 2017) officers were called to 1,069 incidents of hare coursing, an increase of 44 per cent on the previous year (April 2015-March 2016 742 incidents).

Chief Inspector James Sutherland from the Rural Crime Action Team (RCAT) said: "Hare coursing remains one of the biggest crimes to affect our rural communities between September and February, particularly in South Cambridgeshire, East Cambridgeshire and Fenland.

"Driving hare coursing out of the county is a priority for RCAT and we will do all we can to catch those responsible and bring them to justice."

The Hunting Act 2004 made hare coursing illegal and anyone convicted of the offence can be fined. Hare courses could also face a criminal behaviour order, seizure of vehicles and other property and a driving ban.

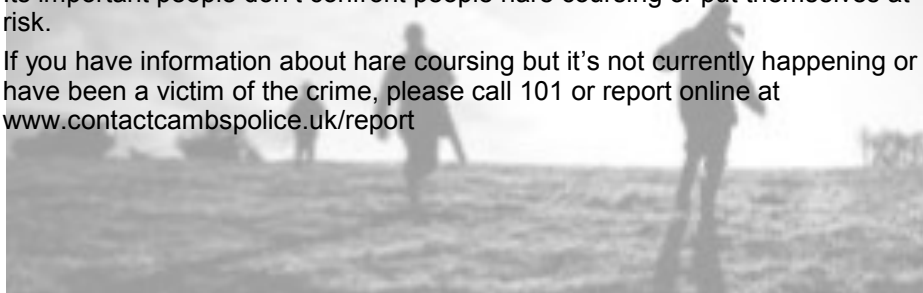
The most obvious sign of hare coursing is a group of vehicles parked in a rural area, perhaps by a gateway to farmland, on a grass verge, on a farm track or bridle path.

Landowners are urged to consider blocking entrances to their fields with ditches, fencing or trees or even barriers like barrels filled with concrete.

Anyone who sees hare coursing taking place is asked to contact police immediately on 999 and provide officers with a description of the people involved, any registration numbers and vehicle descriptions and the location and direction of travel.

It's important people don't confront people hare coursing or put themselves at risk.
