

Village Pond Update

The pond is a central and much-loved feature of the village and over the years has had various working parties involved in maintaining it. The most recent pond working party was created in October 2020 to organise maintenance of the pond and to resolve the longstanding issue of water retention. Various investigations have taken place and reports have been drawn up to develop a solution. There may be an issue with the water source and blocks in the drains, which is being further investigated. The clay puddling has been damaged, leaving about 50-80cm of silt. Most recently, the pond has become overgrown and in need of a tidy up. This year has seen a good number of ducklings and moorhens born, but it is concerning to see them without enough water.

At the recent September Parish Council meeting, it was agreed that remedial work needed to the pond must be carefully timed, to use the window of opportunity whilst the pond was empty while minimising disruption to wildlife.

A sum of money from the Parish Council has been set aside to carry out this work. The job was far too large for a team of volunteers, so professional pond contractors have been approached to clear the deep layer of silt and remove the overgrown vegetation. The job is likely to include the temporary removal of the island to facilitate the setting down of a strong pond liner. Some of the vegetation will also be reinstated or replaced.

We hope that the village will once again enjoy the asset of a beautiful pond, that is well cared for whilst retaining the wildlife.

Comberton Cricket Club 2021 Season Review







Over the last year, I have been emphasising to the Environment Agency the water shortages in South Cambridgeshire. Therefore, I welcome the news that South Cambs has officially been designated a water stressed area. We need new, innovative thinking to overcome this serious issue and I look forward to participating in conversations to find a solution. I am, however, greatly concerned by plans to build 49,000 new homes in our area over the next twenty years, quite literally doubling the size of Cambridge. This is simply not sustainable and risks putting our local environment and resources in danger.

I had a productive meeting recently with the Mayor of the Combined Authority. Amongst other things, we discussed the importance of reliable on-road buses and the potential impact of East-West Rail's preferred route on South Cambs.

As we come to the beginning of the new school year, I have been working with my parliamentary colleagues in Cambridgeshire to lobby for additional funding for local schools. I am delighted our efforts have resulted in such substantial increases. Meridian Primary will receive an additional 4.4%, taking their funding to £ 4,409 per pupil for the coming school year, whilst Comberton Village College has received a further 3.4%, taking their funding to £5,751 per pupil. I know it has been a challenging time for many students and it is fantastic the Village College and Meridian Primary are both able to return to pre-covid teaching. I wish all of you starting at school the best of luck.
