Comberton Pond Working Group

National Lottery Funding

We are delighted to announce that we have received £10,000 from the National Lottery Community Fund, which will enable us to carry out the pond renovations to a high specification.

Environmental Survey

A survey was carried out by Greenlight Environmental Consultancy in December and their conclusions were as follows:

"As the site offers limited aquatic habitats, the proposed plans to reline the existing pond are considered beneficial and will provide more stable aquatic habitats. The pond will be less prone to fluctuation in water levels, and once established this will increase nesting and foraging habitat for a range of species."

To ensure there is no impact on wildlife they suggested works should take place outside the breeding season i.e. before March and after August.

Works to start before end February

Works on the pond are planned to start before the end of February. Fen Group Ltd, who are experienced in pond renovation, have been appointed to carry out the work, which is likely to last a week, during which Green End pathway to the west will not be accessible. Traffic measures will be put in place to ensure safety at all times.

Thanks to all those who have contacted the Pond Working group regarding the inflow and outflow pipes beside the houses in Green End. It has been very helpful in our continuing investigations and still remains somewhat of a mystery!



Message from Treasurer

Newbie Beekeeper

When we moved to the village 2 years ago I was able to realise an ambition – I started beekeeping. I started by attending the fabulous beekeeping course run over the winter by the Cambridgeshire Beekeepers' Association (CBKA) which covers all the basics. My father is a beekeeper and turned up with a hive in the car transported from Cheshire and I was now responsible for the husbandry of a colony of about 50,000 bees.

My learning curve was steep as COVID lockdown hit at the main time of year when bees are prone to swarming. The pandemic meant that we had started having a shared cup of tea over the fence with our neighbours and during one brew up we heard a distant hum which turned out to be a bivouac of bees clustered on a branch in our garden. I had heard what to do if you want to rehouse a swarm but I now needed to do it for real. I phoned one of the course tutors who gave me the confidence to don my bee suit. I found my secateurs and cut the branch the bees had settled on. The swarm then dropped into the box I had left below. Yippee job done and I felt like a proper apiculturist. The following morning I was knocked back as the swarm had up and left again.

Two years later I am aware that it is a steep learning curve and the bees know best!

Are you a Comberton beekeeper? The CBKA has a series of meet-ups in local pubs. I am hosting a meeting on Tuesday 22nd March at The Three Horseshoes in Comberton. It will be a chance to share stories and seek advice. If you are interested in joining please email me at ruthcolenso@gmail.com

Flooding – be prepared and know what to do

Many residents across Cambridgeshire will remember the wet weather we experienced during the Christmas period and the weeks that followed last year.

Whether the cause is excess surface water, blocked ditches and drains or rivers overflowing, flooding is very upsetting and could happen to anyone.

There are a number of organisations who have responsibility for managing flood risk in Cambridgeshire and each of these organisations work hard to invest in flood management maintenance and infrastructure that will provide the most benefit to communities affected by flooding. We can't stop flooding, but we work to limit the impact.

And as residents and business owners, you have an important role to play. Being prepared and knowing what to do if your home or business floods is vital. Here are some top tips:

- Check if your property is in danger of being flooded by visiting https://www.gov.uk/check-flooding
- Register with Environment Agency Flood Warnings Direct service by visiting https://www.gov.uk/sign-up-for-flood-warnings or call Floodline on 0345 988 1188
- If you're in a flood risk area, find out about insurance https://www.floodre.co.uk/ and how to reduce your premiums https://www.floodre.co.uk/flood-resources/
- Buy or make your own sandbags. A quick internet search will list stockists or show how to make them. Do not rely on being given them by the local authority as many do not keep a supply to hand out.
- Have a plan for what you will do if your home floods there's some great advice here https://check-for-flooding.service.gov.uk/plan-ahead-for-flooding
- Move people, pets and valuables to a safer place (for example, upstairs). Be cautious, the flood water may be hiding hidden hazards underneath and cause furniture to be unstable.


