## From the Editor

There is much talk of the rising costs of living and we are seeing the effects of this in Comberton. The Village Hall lettings charges are being reviewed and are likely to rise, and we have also had to increase our advertising rates for this magazine for the first time since 2008.

The increase is necessary for a number of reasons. Printing costs have risen in recent months, with paper alone rising by 40%, and we can no longer absorb these costs. Also, the number of copies we print each month has increased to cater for the new houses being built in the village. For example, the recent development at Bennell Farm has added nearly 100 homes to our circulation.

The Comberton Contact is produced and distributed by volunteers; we receive no funding from the Parish Council (unlike many other village publications) and are reliant on our advertisers to fund the printing costs. Please mention the Comberton Contact when you use their services.





# Wildlife Ponds - Funding Available!

Ponds are a cherished part of the parish landscape; familiar historic features found at the heart of most village centres and in the wider countryside. Sadly, due to changes in land use and agricultural practices, the UK has lost around 50% of ponds in the 20th Century. Those remaining are often threatened by pollution. This means the many species of plant and animal that rely on them are also under threat.

Excitingly, funding is now available in certain parts of Cambridgeshire for the restoration and creation of clean water wildlife ponds capable of supporting great crested newts. The funding is part of Natural England's District Level Licencing scheme (DLL), a new strategy for compensating the loss of newt habitats, which seeks to provide new ponds and bigger, better, more joined-up habitat for this orange-bellied amphibian at a landscape scale.

In Cambridgeshire there is a high demand for such wildlife ponds through the DLL scheme. Most of the 150 or so pond projects we have delivered to date have been fully funded under the scheme. We are seeking local farmers, smallholders, large rural garden owners, land-based businesses and parish-owned land to create and restore more such ponds. Let's do something brilliant for wildlife!

# **Encroachment on Highways**

I have a plea to householders in Comberton. While walking round the village (often during Covid lockdowns), I've noticed how in many places, garden hedges have encroached on the highways. This makes walking on the pavements and footpaths difficult or impossible, and is a real problem to mothers with pushchairs or invalids with wheelchairs.

You can see the highway boundary by looking at the line of walls and gateposts along the road. Another key indicator is lamp posts and telephone/electricity posts which were almost always set within the highway area. If your hedge comes further out than your gateposts, or any telephone posts, or next-door's wall, then you are probably encroaching on the highway. One can also consult old photos of the highway from the early 20th century (from e.g. the Cambridgeshire Collection) to see the original road and footpath widths. If your hedge is encroaching, then please cut it back to inside your property line.

In some cases it may just be that the hedge has not been trimmed or cut back enough, but in other cases, a hedge has been planted far too close to the boundary. Over decades, a hedge, even if trimmed, will grow to at least three feet thick, sometimes more. So the new hedge should be planted with its stems at least two feet inside the property boundary, so as not to encroach beyond the boundary. I've seen a couple of new hedges planted right along the boundary line, that are bound to encroach as they grow. If you have one like that, or one planted from bushes or trees that have got out of hand, then maybe it's time to grub it up and replant it further back. Many of the highways in Comberton have been used by pedestrians for a thousand years – let's not lose that usability in our generation!

# **Beating the Bounds**

Friends of St Mary's revive an old custom

In the March edition of Contact we spoke of an 'Easy Walking Event to re-enact an ancient practice'. What did we mean?



Perhaps it all began with the Roman god Terminus, the god who protected Boundary Markers and was in some way an inspiration for this custom. His Feast day was 23rd February – but things can be changed!

During the Middle Ages and into the Nineteenth Century, the Parish was responsible for its own law and order as well as care of its poor, elderly and sick. It was important for everyone to know the Boundaries of the Parish. Children and young adults needed to be taught.

To pick up on this necessity, the Church added a religious purpose to the instruction. Changing the time of year to May for an annual Parish Boundary Walk, the second purpose was to ask (Rogation) for God's blessing on the greening crops and for a bountiful harvest to come. The combination became the Custom of 'Beating the Bounds'. In the Church's Calendar, the Sunday before Ascension Day is called Rogation Sunday and is associated with 'Beating the Bounds'. This year, Friends of St Mary's will hold a Beating the Bounds on Rogation Sunday afternoon, 22nd May 2022.

Traditionally, the walking party would stop at each boundary mark, whether an ancient tree or a boundary stone, to teach the young folk. Apparently various methods were used to help them remember. There will be no sticks and no beating on our walks!

We shall gather for a Longer Walk or a Shorter Walk. You can choose which one to take. They will happen at the same time.

Comberton does not have as many footpaths as some villages - such as Toft. It is not possible to walk all the way around the boundary of our Parish, but our map specialist Paul Hardy will be on hand. The Longer Walk will turn west, finding the Parish Boundary close to the Village College. After walking a distance along this Parish Boundary, the walk will turn east and follow a figure of eight pattern. The Shorter Walk will be suitable for families and buggies and will pick up on several points of historic interest nearer the heart of the village. This walk will be circular. In both cases we propose to start at 2 pm and finish by 4 pm around St Mary's Church. We hope to have some other specialists walking with us to show and explain the Boundaries, the Church Lands, the Wilding Project, as well as inside and around St Mary's Church.






