



Churchyard Maintenance

There was a lot of grass in the churchyard this year and some visitors may have felt it looked 'untidy'. The change was intentional; the churchyard is now managed for nature and nature abhors tidiness.

We are now in the third year of changing the mowing regimes in the churchyard to try to establish distinct habitat types to encourage greater diversity in the species which visit each year. The biggest change is that the vegetation is allowed to grow during the summer and different areas are uncut either until July, to emulate a hay meadow, or until autumn to encourage later flowering perennials. We also allow the grass beneath the larger trees to grow throughout the year. An area of short grass is maintained around the church building for amenity use and to provide a third, contrasting style of vegetation.

The changes mean that the churchyard may be seen to act as a hub with a series of paths and hedgerows radiating as corridors down to Bourn Brook, to the south, the causeway and Tit Brook then through the fields in the centre of the village to the north, the Drift and Watts Wood to the East and towards Toft through the Meridian Golf course to the west. This network highlights the importance of corridors along which plants and animals may spread. It demonstrates the biodiversity resource in and around Comberton as an essential part of the Green Belt and a buffer against inappropriate development.

In the spring of 2023 we installed some swift nest boxes in the west side of the church tower from which we broadcast swift calls in the morning and evening during May and June. We hope that in two or three years some swifts will settle and use the boxes to raise young.

Some of the nature enthusiasts in the village are helping us to record species of animals and plants that use the churchyard. The causeway from the Church to South Street and the allotments is an important part of this diversity as it provides opportunity for hedgerow birds and insects. We can already demonstrate how important the changes we are making to churchyard management are to local wildlife. There are about 130 species of plants in the churchyard. We also have healthy and diverse populations of birds (29 species), butterflies (16 species) and mammals including bats (six and five species respectively, including the rare Barbastelle) using the area regularly.

During the autumn and winter we will do some general tidying up and prepare to make a fresh series of observations next summer.



Update on the Comberton Greenways from the Parish Council

Some residents may have noticed signs and received letters indicating that roadworks are starting in Comberton related to the Comberton Greenways.

Recently, a Traffic Regulation Order was issued relating to:

- New speed limits in the village
- Raised tables
- Reduction of junction width
- · New pedestrian crossings.

An update on the Comberton Greenways is given below:

Works on Long Road and adjacent roads

Improvements to Long Road and adjacent roads, including speed-limiting measures, are planned as part of the Comberton Greenway. However, these works will not occur for many months, and design drawings have not been produced. As a result, while we have noted residents' comments, we will not discuss these plans until designs are available.

Speed limits

The Traffic Regulation Order proposed a new 40 mph limit on Long Road up to a point south of Branch Road, and a new 20 mph from that point down to the junction to Barton Road, and on Barton Road and West Street where the limit is currently 30 mph.

We have heard feedback from residents who wish for the speed limit reduction to encompass all streets in the village. We are therefore working with the Greenway team to obtain a 20 mph speed limit on all roads currently limited to 30 mph, and 40 mph on the Green End and Branch Road section which is currently limited to 60mph.

Works on Barton Road, West Street and adjacent roads

The proposed design includes three raised tables (similar to a speed bump but with an expanded flat surface) corresponding to essential crossing points for pedestrians:

- In front of Comberton Village College. It is a condition on the Co-Op planning application that
 a zebra crossing is built. The Co-op is paying for these works via what is known as Section
 106.
- At the Green End/South Street junction, providing informal and safer crossing points for the
 dentist, GP, playgroup, pub, and village shop at this busy junction that currently has only one
 zebra crossing.
- Next to the junction with Harbour Avenue, providing an informal crossing point for primary school children.

In addition, it is proposed to decrease the width of junctions with side streets and add raised tables at the entrance to some side streets. This would apply to Harbour Avenue, Woottens Close, Kentings, and Barrons Way at their junctions with Barton Road.

The other works proposed for the village will be presented via detailed and simplified drawings, with an opportunity for discussion and questions, at an information event on Wednesday, 8th November, from 2 pm to 6:30 pm at the Village Hall.

All the proposed works aim to:

- Enforce a new 20mph speed limit across the village;
- Force cars to slow down at essential crossing points, either on the main road or at side streets;
- Reduce street crossing distances for pedestrians;
- Support street crossing for wheelchair users and pushchairs.
