Comberton Men's Shed



The Herringland Charity

How often have you looked at the village sign by the pond and noticed the lady with the herrings?

The exact origins of this charity are obscure, but it would appear to date back from at least the early 18th century, when a field, situated on the east side of the drift that runs to the south from Long Road, was left to the village by a benefactor in his will.

Rental of the northern part of this field was to be applied to the upkeep of the church and of the cobbled causeway leading to it; the Church Land. The rent from



the southern part, approximately seven acres, was for the purchase of a barrel of herrings from Lowestoft, to be distributed to 'the settled poor of the Parish' in Lent, according to the size of their families: thus the Herring Land, as commemorated on the village sign.

However, it seems that by 1834, or earlier, when the annual rent of the Herringland was £9, money rather than herrings was given on Good Friday.

Quite recently, it has been agreed with the Charity Commissioners that the money can be used for wider benefits to Comberton, rather than just the needy, and over recent years the charity in addition to supporting individuals and organisations, has amongst other things, donated to the play equipment on the recreation ground, provided three benches, and supported the holiday hamper scheme.

Following the sad death of Dr Tony Hoskins, who had been involved for at least forty years both as committee member and Chairman, there is a vacancy for a Trustee. It is certainly not an onerous job with usually one meeting a year, and occasional decisions on expenditure; please do let me know if you would like some more information.





The Car Park at St Mary's Church Comberton

The car park upgrade by J Cobb and sons, Orwell, started work on 29th April. Recommended by R J Carter Construction Ltd here at Vision Park, they finished in four days. In that time the whole area was 'shaved' level and the larger part laid with planings, heavy rolled and spread with a thick layer of shingle.

The lesser section was managed differently. After levelling, a shallow trench-line was cut around the perimeter close to the gateway into the churchyard, defining the area to become the disability parking zone. Cement poured into the trench received the concrete edging slabs and tarmac was rolled. In the planning stage we considered our options but it came down to this choice for the most long-lasting result. Beauty gave way to a robust finish!

Our Churchwarden Michael is very knowledgeable on shingle-laid car parks! Following the last shingle spread in 2005, he would rake and level the shingle. Raking will be needed this time too. You can help us by thoughtful parking. The shingle will compact quickest if everyone who can do so chooses to park on the 'beach'.

Let me tell you about the fundraising. St Mary's has a special relationship with Jesus College and we applied to their Proby Trust for a grant. They responded most generously. Consequently, Friends of St Mary's were spared most of this bill. Our other dedicated donor for the disability parking upgrade was the Comberton Herringland Charity who donated £1000! These generous grants, combined with several gifts of £1000 or greater, enabled FOSM successfully to push for an early inspection of the lead covering the Nave roof (see May Contact). The total cost of work on car park, gateway, churchyard wall, north path lighting and nave roof amounts to nearly £33,000! Thank you, donors!

Soon the Quinquennial Inspection Report will be available. It will tell us what else needs fixing. We already know of two other areas of rainwater ingress demanding attention.

There will be a Friends of St Mary's stall at the Church Fete on August Bank Holiday Monday. Come and find us.

"We do not want the Oxford-Cambridge rail link as described in the East West Rail Company's Route Update Announcement and subsequent refinements. We call for these plans to be paused and for a full. transparent and independent review."

"Crime against the countryside," says The Countryside Regeneration Trust

A national charity which promotes nature-friendly farming has issued an open letter to East West Rail (EWR), calling its plans to build a railway line in Cambridgeshire "a crime against the countryside."

The Countryside Regeneration Trust (CRT), which owns 400-acre Lark Rise Farm near the villages of Barton and Comberton, is calling for EWR to change its proposed route through regenerative arable farmland known as Westfield.

The charity has also raised concerns about ecological surveys carried out by EWR on its land.

The CRT is calling on EWR to work with them to protect the specialist habitat at Lark Rise Farm and to rethink its proposal for the southern route through Cambridgeshire.

Conservation Officer Vince Lea said: "We have written an open letter to EWR calling for action.

"The route will be disastrous for the Cambridgeshire countryside. It is the most expensive of the options previously suggested. It has the greatest impact on biodiversity and on residents of south Cambridgeshire.

"EWR will take out a vast area of productive farmland, not just under the footprint of the railway line itself but all the surrounding land used during the construction or converted into 'mitigation' features. We would like to talk to them about the environmental impact and can share the results of our long-term monitoring of the site, with over 20 years of breeding bird surveys, winter bird counts, otter and water vole surveys, butterfly surveys and knowledge of rare arable plants."

Tim Scott, the tenant farmer at Lark Rise Farm for 30 years, said: "We are in the 24th year of nature recovery at Lark Rise. We have numerous Red List Species, and we are in the top one per cent of our county for these species and most, if not all of these, will be lost because of the railway.

"I question whether this folly is needed at all, but all common sense would suggest the northern route is the more appropriate one."
