





In South Cambridgeshire District Council, Civil Parking Enforcement (CPE) has transferred the responsibilities for on-street parking from the police to Cambridgeshire County Council. Charge Penalty Notice can be issued for illegal parking, such as parking on yellow lines (including on the verge), within 10 metres of a junction or opposite a junction. CPE is leading to more frequent enforcement so we advise residents and visitors to be particularly careful when parking. We are investigating the situation relating to the informal laybys on South Street and recommend avoiding parking there for the time-being.

Extensive works took place at the pond

last year. The island will not be reinstated because it was home to rats that were attacking the ducks, it was reducing the pond depth so increasing the risk of the pond drying out in summer, and the plants on the island were drinking a lot of pond water. We now have many ducks (a resident counted 48), and we do not think they need any additional shelter. Please remember foods like bread and crackers have no nutritional value to ducks, can cause malnutrition and painful deformities. You can feed ducks cracked corn, oats, rice, birdseed, frozen peas, chopped lettuce, or sliced grapes.

The Parish Council is aware of the Notice of Landowner Deposit placed near the path that connects Green End to the Recreation Ground. This notice relates to the land adjacent to the path and not the path itself, plus the area of land forming the retirement village planning application. A map of the area can be viewed online. This notice is a standard procedure that landowners can undertake, to prevent a claim to a public right of way, under S.31(6) of the Highways Act 1980.


