

It's 'Comberton Autumn Show' time again! Our 71st Show is on Saturday 14th September in the Meridian Primary School.

By now every house in Comberton should have received a copy of the Show Brochure (*if you haven't, pick a copy up at the Local Post Offices*), please look through it and plan your entries, there is a class for everyone! Again this year all exhibit entries are free and can be emailed to <u>combertonshow@gmail.com</u> or delivered to the Show Secretary, they must be pre-booked by the evening of Friday 13th September; no entries will be accepted on the Saturday. Staging is between **8.30 and 10.30am** on the day; you simply collect your entry cards and display your exhibit, stewards will be on hand to guide you to the appropriate area. As the entries are free there will be no monetary prizes but prize cards and trophies will be awarded as usual. The Show opens to the Public at **3pm.** Our judges give their time voluntarily to come

and officiate so please enter; we like to give them a sufficient number of entries to ponder over and make their trip worthwhile!

Vegetables, Fruit and Flowers: A mixed bag of weather again, this year we went from deluge to drought, a complete reversal of last year, but a lot of plants are looking very healthy, some maybe a bit later than usual which should be good for the Show. However, prime condition or not, try an entry, the weather has been the same for everyone and it could be your year for the prize.

Remember the 'Harry Sewell Trophy', it is a restricted class, in this otherwise open show, for **residents of Comberton** or holders of an **allotment in Comberton**; this display of 3 different vegetables (*from a very long list*) gives you a better chance of winning without any outside competition.

Cookery and Preserves: There are **11** cookery classes including one set recipe for a '*Chocolate & Sultana Tiffin*' and **7** different preserve classes; try your hand at winning the 'Evelyn Watts Trophy' awarded for highest points in cookery. Of course there is also the eagerly contested **Men only Cake** class for the 'Gerry Hall Tankard', the challenge this year is for the men to bake a '*Coffee & Walnut Cake*' to a set recipe.

Rev'd Chris Westgarth left the Parish Council in July. Chris had served on the Parish Council for 25 years, including many years as Chair. We are indebted

to her for her time and dedication over the years. Thank you Chris!

We are delighted that several residents have been co-opted to the Parish Council in recent months, especially as these are entirely voluntary roles. As this bulletin goes to print,



we have only one vacancy! Please contact the clerk if you are interested in joining us.

Parish Councillors have talked to several residents about the issues they face with sewage: toilets backing up, sewage spills in wet rooms and in gardens, and drainage issues. We are still

collating evidence to build a case. If any sewage issue affects you, please fill in the online form

(https://tinyurl.com/4sud93xh) or contact the clerk. Copies of email exchanges with Anglian Water and pictures/videos are particularly helpful.



Parish Council Bulletin (continued)

The first phase of the Comberton Greenway has been delivered. It included two new zebra crossings, a 20 mph limit on Barton Road and West Road, several raised tables, and some junction modifications to help pedestrians crossing roads and to reduce speeds in the village. We thank you for your patience during the roadworks.

The next phase of the Comberton Greenway will not take place for a while although speed reduction measures on Long Road may be fasttracked. Note that from 27th of August 2024 the Greenway team will be out on site undertaking



ground investigation surveys in and around Comberton. The data collected from these surveys will be used to inform the civil design of the Greenways. All landowners impacted have been made aware. The surveys will last approximately 4 weeks in total.



Please also note that, as part of the Barton Greenways, road works will soon begin on the A603 (Barton Road) between Junction 12 and the entrance to Cambridge. The works will predominately be undertaken under

temporary traffic light control between 9am-3.30pm.

The Parish Council handyman has recently replanted the sensory garden on Harbour Avenue. If you live in the area, we would be very thankful if you could sometimes water the plants during dry spells, particularly while the plants are not established. We hope you enjoy this improved area.



The Parish Council ran a litter picking scheme this summer for young people. Families or friends could collect litter picking equipment and picture themselves with their results. All participants will

get a certificate, and the three pickers collecting the most litter will be presented with an Amazon voucher at the October Parish Council meeting. There is still time to participate! Contact the clerk for information.





Lucy was the UK's first female bomb disposal expert. She has now become Cambridge University's first woman marshal in its 809-year history.




