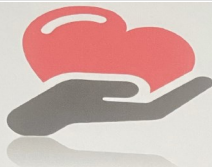

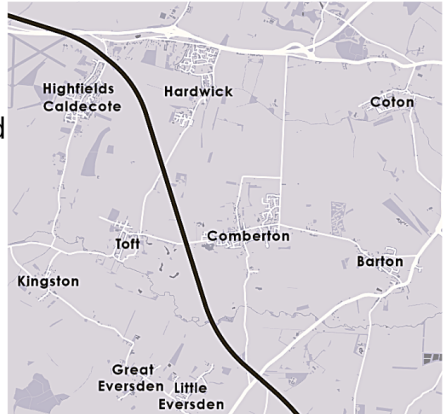

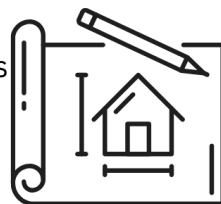
Parish Council Bulletin (continued)



Cllr Michel and Cllr Haslop met with two Police Community Service Officers (PCSO) to discuss recent occurrences of crime and anti-social behaviour. Most issues we reported had already been investigated and acted upon.

The PCSOs would like to remind residents that all incidents of crime and anti-social behaviour should be reported to the police by calling 101 or visiting www.cambs.police.uk. The police does not monitor social media and cannot act if incidents are not reported directly to them. Similarly, the Parish Council can only consider matters raised directly via the clerk's email address or Parish Council meetings. If someone is seriously injured, in immediate danger, or if there is a threat to public safety, please call 999.

It is likely that the Endurance/retirement village planning application for 200 dwellings in Comberton will be considered at a District Council Planning Meeting on 15th January 2025 at the South Cambridgeshire Hall in Cambourne. We have been told that the Planning Committee takes note of strong public attendance at such meetings.

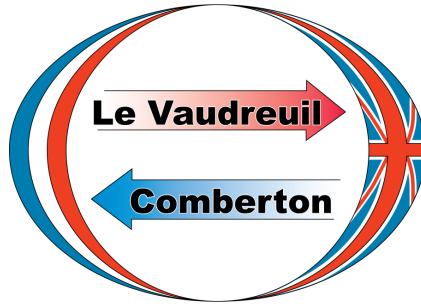

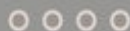
