

In Praise of Practical Skills

I came to Comberton Village College in 1978. After teaching in Ankara Turkey from 1967-70 I took a post at a new comprehensive school in Lincoln. The school leaving age had gone from 15 to 16.

I, and others, set up "link courses" at the local tech, art college and college of agriculture. Every afternoon many pupils went to college to learn skills in : painting and decorating, bricklaying and plastering, car mechanics, hairdressing, beauty treatment, many agricultural skills, and others. Most loved it. The school bought "Mirror dinghy" kits which pupils, and their dads built and many learned to sail them.

At Comberton, when I arrived, practical subjects were still very much a part of the school curriculum. I may be misinformed but talking to young people now "practical skills" seem to be much less of a priority than "academic skills".

In my opinion this is a massive mistake. Artificial Intelligence will, I'm told, soon replace most solicitors, accountants, office staff of all kinds.

We will still need skills and personal service in future years. Bricklayers, plumbers, roofers, gardeners, carers, hairdressers and loads of other individually skilled people are going to be needed more and more. In our village there are many successful skilled tradesmen who are vital to our well-being as a community.

Is it possible that this emphasis on academic skills by schools and on giving a university education for perhaps too many, will be seen in years to come as a massive error?


