





Chesterton Tower

Chesterton Tower is a Grade 1 medieval tower located in Chapel Street, Chesterton, Cambridge. The two-storey 14th-century tower is the former residence of Italian procurators of the abbot of Vercelli in Italy. Built from field stones, clunch, brick and ashlar quoins, the tower is a complete dwelling with vaulted ceilings, a spiral staircase and garderobe. A restoration was completed in 1949.







Comberton Allotments & Gardens Association Report on the 72nd Comberton Autumn Show

Once again the Show, held on 13th September, proved very popular and successful; it was attended by around 134 adults plus their children, a noticeable reduction from previous years; exhibit entries were almost back up to our 2023 level of 500 after showing a 20% drop last year; increases occurred in almost all areas; a pleasant surprise for us and about the right number of exhibits for a good show. Additionally the Comberton Playgroup submitted 40 paintings providing a colourful display. Unfortunately the Meridian School was unable to facilitate paintings from their pupils this year so the walls of the Main Hall only had a handful of children's paintings on display, probably explaining the reduction in numbers of parents visiting; hopefully both paintings and parents will be back in full next year.

Once again the weather conditions were challenging for gardeners, so for the vegetable, fruit & flower entries to show a 16% increase on last year was surprising considering the very hot summer and it's effect on vegetables and flowers in both quality and ripening times; although it was evident that Tomatoes and Peppers and some of the good quality blooms, evident on the magnificently colourful Flower table, have benefited most from the sunshine.

Cookery entries increased significantly to 53 in total including 32 jars of preserves and 6 entries in the fiercely contested Men's Cake competition, all of which gave our judge plenty to sample.

The Handicraft section boasted 55 entries including 10 paintings and drawings, including our recently added class of 'Original artwork created on a computer'; again showing the amazing talent that resides in this village.

Homemade wine was slightly down with 22 bottles entered in the various classes, I guess sadly reflecting the loss of a long term exhibitor this summer and, as every year, very little of the wine remained at the end of the afternoon by the time the Judge and the visitors had given the bottles a thorough sampling!

Photography entries more than doubled from last year to 65 but sadly only one from the children's class, the number was particularly pleasing as it is so difficult to pick new subjects every year which will inspire.

Children's entries are the great success story this year with 97 entries overall, 50% up on last year which, was itself, double that of 2023; hopefully we can continue to inspire the young people and our thanks goes to the parents for their part in this.

The Best Kept Allotment competition was judged this summer on the Long Road Site and congratulations go to the winner, David Burman.

We are always keen to receive constructive feedback and suggestions for keeping these and indeed all classes up to date and relevant to current trends (any ideas can be emailed to me).
