

An update from your local MP, Pippa Heylings

Some of you may have seen footage of me from parliament with a bandage on my hand – and that is because I took an unfortunate fall while out walking in the countryside during the holidays and broke my finger. Thank you for all the concerned comments and well wishes and rest assured this has not stopped me from getting stuck in now that we are back and already into February.

2026 promises to be a big year for our area with changes to the Integrated Health Board (the way our NHS services are organised) and local government reorganisation on the horizon. The local elections in May this year will be the last ever set of local elections for South Cambridgeshire District Council and are important as they will decide the political makeup of the new unitary authority.

Eight years ago, South Cambridgeshire District Council was on the brink of being declared a failing authority – now it is one of the best run councils in the country. The council is investing in the things that people often tell me matter most to them - like tackling the cost of living, supporting our healthcare services, building affordable homes for local people, and protecting our green spaces & environment.

Finally, I secured the meeting I had been requesting for months with the Rail Minister, Lord Hendy, on East West Rail. Even though it did not take place in South Cambridgeshire as I had originally requested, it was a worthwhile meeting and I put residents' concerns directly to him. The good news coming from this meeting is that Lord Hendy agreed that it made absolute sense for him to meet directly with the parish councils affected by EWR and we are now arranging for this to happen.

Alongside your local Lib Dem councillors, I have continued to campaign for more engagement from East West Rail and attended multiple meetings with them and with the parish councils affected, the latest of which was held at Haslingfield Village Hall. I committed to finding a way for them to meet with the rail minister so that they could ask questions directly on the Government's position on the southern route; the business case for the project; and the plans for freight on the line and I am pleased that at the time of writing, this looks to be happening soon.

The Parish Council Tax, also known as the precept, is the small portion of your council tax that helps fund local services and projects within the village. This includes things like maintaining community spaces, supporting local initiatives, running community events and meeting the everyday running costs of the Parish Council.

For the coming year, the precept will increase by 5%. For a band D household, this equates to an increase of £3.88 per year. This will help ensure the Parish Council can continue to support the village and meet rising costs.

FOSM Chronicles Part 1; 2014 -2017

This year, 2026, marks 10 years since the founding of the Friends of St Mary's Church Comberton (FOSM). In 2016, during his last month as Team Rector, Revd. Mike Booker turned to a group of friends for help in a crisis. St Mary's faced not one, but two massive bills. At a meeting that September we agreed to form a charitable trust.

The lesser bill, to be paid directly, was for the north aisle roof repair. Thieves had stripped roof lead on the night of 29th April 2016.

Insurance cover required that security was upgraded. Roof re-leading was completed on 1st July 2016. Unbelievably, the thieves returned to steal more lead on the 15th July 2016 – only 2 weeks later! Photo from July 2016 - plastic cladding again.



The Parochial Church Council (PCC) faced combined costs of a second re-roofing and a new security system, fitted on 31st August 2016.

Repeat re-roofing took place in early October. The total of £27,000 was diminished by a VAT rebate. Cambridgeshire Historic Church Trust gave a modest grant and made a larger loan, to be repaid over 4 years. This loan repayment became the first fundraising target for the Friends.

The larger bill would arise when the 2014 Quinquennial Inspection repairs were made. The church was reported to be 'in poor condition'. The Architect's estimate to put this right - in excess of £50,000.

In October 2017, Architect and PCC re-examined Q1 2014. A specification for Urgent Only repairs resulted in an estimate of £35,000. We used this figure in our FOSM Fundraising campaign of 2018 onward until our second fundraising Target was achieved. This work began in 2018.

In March 2017 we transferred more than £3,000 to the PCC. In May the Bedford Gallery Quire gave a concert in Church and in June we held an Inaugural gathering in St Mary's Church, featuring guided tours. Later in the year we staged two more musical concerts.

By the end of 2017 the Friends had received 3 grants with a total of £5,500 and held over £10,000 in the bank. We are so grateful for the generosity of our supporters.
