Time for a new Comberton Tennis Club?

As I type this the March temperature is 20 degrees and the winds are light. I wrote in our March issue of Brian Cook and his wife Margaret and what they did for our community years ago. I entitled it "Local Hero". I did not mention by name Dr. Malcolm Wright and Nerys, his wife who have done a tremendous amount for the village community (and who will not forgive me for mentioning their names, Sorry Malcolm).

I wrote of the thriving tennis club on the rec where up to 40 people met to play and socialise on a Sunday afternoon. Malcolm and Nerys were very much involved in the tennis club on the rec. There were several very good players and various teams and friendly competitions throughout the week. It was very much a social atmosphere with great "mix-ins"

A few years ago the decision was made to move the club to the courts at the back of the village college. Some thought it a good idea, others thought, correctly as it turned out, that the club would eventually die.

The advantages of playing on the village college courts were obvious. There were more and arguably better courts. We also acquired a "clubhouse". The major disadvantage was that the club moved from the village centre and many people forgot, or never realised, its existence.

The club continued for a number of years and I became a self-appointed Saturday morning organiser and we often had four courts being used in the Winter months which was unusual for a village club.

For various reasons over the years club evenings and weekends became less well attended by better players and men, in particular, drifted away to other clubs or, like me, gave up playing. Finally the club ceased to exist. I'm sure that there were other reasons for its demise.

The two courts at the rec are still there. The nets are in poor condition (I've done basic repairs) but surely a village the size of Comberton can support, once again, a thriving tennis club. Spring is here and I confidently expect a perfect Summer.

I am an old man, but I'm a qualified coach (I coached in the U.S.A.) and I would gladly help anyone who would like to either begin to play or to get back to playing. I am a very sympathetic helper.

It just needs a few people to set up a new club. Perhaps contact the editor if you are willing and he will pass on your emails to me and I'll try to coordinate an initial meeting.



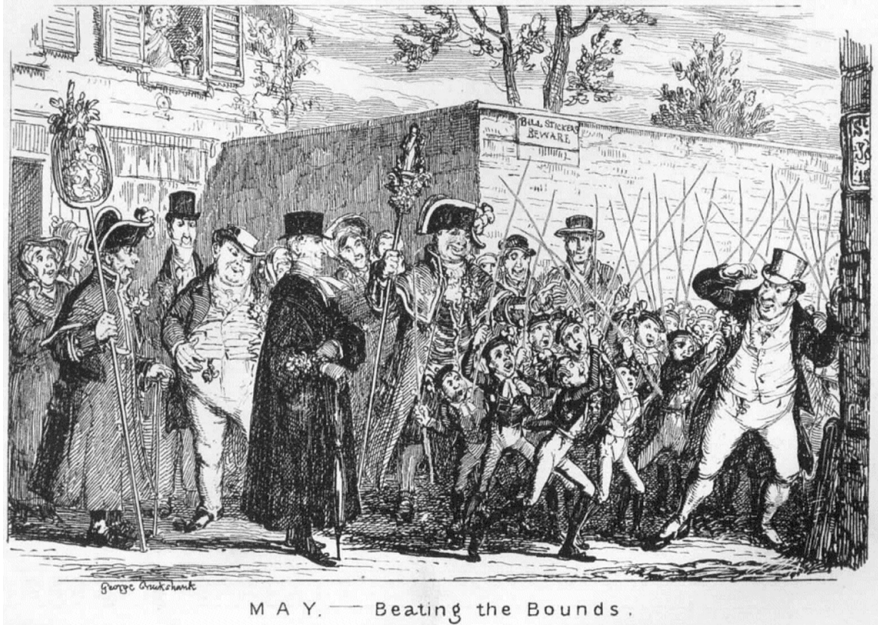

'These sticks would originally have been of birch or willow, both being of significance to pre-Christian tribes. Birch has connection with besoms, which have ancient connections with pagan festivals however the willow possessing a close association with water appears to have predominated in medieval times. The sticks were known as rods or wands. The bark was removed exposing the white wood beneath. The English folk-song "Stripping The Willow" is a relatively modern record of these practices.' ref (Bucks Archaeological Record 1986)

Out and About - Godmanchester

Godmanchester is only a short drive from Comberton and is a delightful place to visit. There are over 100 listed buildings, the largest building is a Tudor farm house which dates back to 1600. This farm house was restored in 1995.

Chinese Bridge (see photo) has been a landmark of Godmanchester since 1827. Over the years it has been rebuilt twice, in the 1860's and in 1960. Do take a walk over the bridge to Portholm Meadow. In 1910 the meadow was used to build early aircraft. Air displays were held here for the public to enjoy these new flying machines, including James Radley flying his monoplane around the meadow covering 16 miles in 23 minutes.

House of Spies, Farm House, Godmanchester served as a secret SOE (Special Operations Executive) training and transport point from summer 1942. Agents were housed, trained and prepared here before going to RAF Tempsford for secret missions into occupied Europe.

You can take a heritage walk around Godmanchester which takes between 1 and 2 hours.
